A simple plan for an abundant life

Is there someone in your life that appears to have less than you do (financially or otherwise) yet they lack for nothing? Nothing in their house breaks down. They never seem to have to deal with the constant derailments and chaos that you do? How is it that you struggle to get by month to month, week to week yet they are always happy?

The answer is simple one...

SHALOM!!

A husband and wife that strive to be the vessels of peace become like blessing lightning rods. On the other hand, a couple whose home lacks peace will not merit any blessings for they lack the vessel to attract and retain blessings.

*“The vessel that can hold all of Hashem’s blessings – material and spiritual success, good income, health, fertility, wellbeing, joy, holiness, successful and pious children, spiritual ascent, and more – is peace. **Only the vessel of peace can make it possible for us to receive the abundance Hashem blesses us with in both the material and spiritual realms.**”*

Shalom Bayit –Enemy of the Evil One

The Evil Inclination aims to ruin the harmony that exists between man and wife. By destroying the Shalom Bayit everything else can be easily ruined. Without Shalom Bayit a person loses their self-composure and ability to function optimally, thus giving themselves over to the Evil Inclination that much easier. Conversely marital peace strengthens a person affording her power to successfully face any trial or tribulation it is the basic element for soul correction.

Torah – Our weapon of choice

*“Its ways are ways of pleasantness, and all its paths are peace”
Proverbs 3*

Genuine marital peace is best attained and maintained through observing and adhering to the tenants of Torah/Scripture. A woman who heeds the Torah will build her character; she will be slow to anger, strong, and peace-seeking.

Harmony will elude a person that thinks that there is anything of higher importance than marital peace.

Peace above Everything else

An excerpt from "Womens Wisdom"

Hashem placed peace between man and wife above His own Glory. In the Torah's account of the wayward woman – *Parshat Sotah* – we find that if a woman is suspected of adultery her husband must bring her to the Priest, where she swears oath (including the name of Hashem) on a scroll and blots out the ink into the water, which she then drinks. For the sake of proving a woman's innocence to her husband and reestablishing marital peace in their home, Hashem allows His Holy Name to be erased in the water!

Our Sages, of blessed memory, explain that Hashem Himself fulfills all the commandments encompassed in the Torah. However, for the sake of marital peace, Hashem is willing to defy one of the strictest ordinances in the Torah – the prohibition of erasing His Name in whole or in part! Our sages consequently teach that peace is greater even than Hashem's Holy Name, for Hashem allows it to be blotted out in the water for the sake of bringing peace between husband and wife.

The entire world was created for Hashem's Name: "Everyone that is called by My name, and whom I created for My glory, I formed him, yea I made him" (Isaiah 43) Yet Hashem is willing to erase His Name for the sake of peace between a man and wife. **This shows us that the greatest reflection of His Glory is marital peace, the peace that prevails between man and wife.**

Pride or Peace...that is the question

Peace outweighs dignity. Anyone who is unwilling to lower her pride for the sake of marital peace will end up being treated with scorn both inside and outside her home. If you are willing to lose your marital peace for the sake of protecting your pride and prestige will inevitably lose your prestige. Our sages teach that "***honor eludes whoever chases after it***".

She who compromises her own pride and honor for the sake of peace NEVER LOSES. She only gains because peace is the primary vessel for all of Hashem's blessings.
